Important: Reminders and instructions to complete these tasks will be sent to the email you used to apply to Waterloo until the end of June. Beginning in July, information will be sent to your student email. Make it a habit to check both emails regularly through the summer.

JUNE

- □ Register for your Faculty Ready Day, Waterloo Ready webinars and Virtual Speed Friending
- □ Set up your student email and check it regularly!
- □ Stay on top of residence application actions or look for off-campus housing
- □ Apply for your study and work permits, as well as other international student documents as needed

JULY

- □ Attend your Faculty Ready Day in-person or online
- Complete your Waterloo Ready online LEARN modules
- □ Attend Waterloo Ready webinars
- □ Connect with other new students in Virtual Speed Friending
- □ Create a budget for your first year
- □ Apply for Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP) loans if eligible
- □ Apply for scholarships, bursaries and financial aid
- □ Apply for academic accommodations with AccessAbility Services
- □ Arrange for travel to campus from the airport
- □ View your course schedule on Quest

AUGUST

- □ Register for Waterloo Orientation
- \square Become fees arranged ahead of the tuition and fees due date
- □ Apply for a Social Insurance Number if needed, and add it to your Quest account
- □ Prepare for on-campus or off-campus move-in
- □ Submit a photo online for your student card (WatCard)
- Download Regroup Mobile, the UWaterloo community safety app
